#### **Police Officer Requirements\***

**Applicants must:** 

- Be able to successfully pass a physical fitness test, written examination, psychological screening, medical and drug test, extensive personal interview and background examination
- Be a United States Citizen
- Be at least 20 years of age at time of written exam; Be at least 21 years of age at time of hire
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent (GED) education
- Have a valid driver's license
- Be of good moral character





### The Waukegan Police Department Hiring Process

After the written test, applicants will be scheduled for a panel interview and an initial eligibility list will be compiled. An opportunity to apply preference points will be sent out to qualified applicants, then a final eligibility list will be certified. Applicants will undergo, but not limited to, a thorough background investigation, integrity interview, credit check, psychological examination, medical examination, and an additional P.O.W.E.R. test. After successfully passing all components, applicants will attend the police academy. After graduation, officers will be paired with Field Training Officers. Probation for new police officers is 18 months.

Applicants will be required to obtain a Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (P.O.W.E.R.) test card dated between November 21, 2019 and November 21, 2020. This card can be obtained through <u>Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy</u> (NIPSTA), Joliet Junior College, or <u>Triton College</u>.
